

Changes for 2023 - Regulations for Association Judges and Implementing Regulations

The Association Annual Meeting in July adopted changes in the Regulations for Association Judges (OfdVRW). Besides some editorial and explanatory additions, here are the most important changes in brief:

- Future Judge Apprentices must be registered for the mandatory Introductory Seminar through their clubs.
- The registration as an Apprentice Judge Sw is possible 2 years after confirmation as an appointed Association Judge at the earliest.
- In the future, Association Judges will be required to attend further training at least every 4 years without the option of "handling as an alternative".
- The "suspended status as an Association Judge" will only be lifted again upon publication in the Association's magazine, irrespective of the reason for this. Until that time, the Association Judge may not be active.

Implementing Regulations for the OfdVRW

The Executive Board has decided that in the future only the JGHV Landesverbände (LV) will be responsible for conducting or organizing Introductory Seminars for Judge Apprentices. They can organize and hold these seminars themselves or delegate this to a member club of the JGHV. The organizer and responsible party remains the respective LV. For the seminar special training materials are available, which can be obtained from the Business Office.
